11. DIARRHOEA THROUGH WATER

ACTIVITY 11: Blocking the Route TIME: 2 Hours

- Ask the group to think of how we drink water that could enable the transmission of faeces to our mouths.
- Hand out the Transmission pictures (left), and ask each person to come to the front and explain their card.
- Now hand out the cards (right) that show ways to 'block the route' of the transmission of diarrhoea by FLUIDS.
- Discuss if these recommendations are practical and get the group to pledge to change their ways of drinking water.

TRANSMISSION PRACTICES

- 1. Unprotected water source
- 2. Contaminated water source
- 3. Water contaminated during transport
- 4. Use of a dirty container
- 5. Uncovered / badly covered water
- 6. Dangerous / poisonous container
- 7. Pollution while taking water
- 8. Use of shared cups

RECOMMENDED PRACTICES

- Use a protected water source, and ensure it is regularly tested
- 2. Keep water source clean
- 3. Transport water safely without contamination
- 4. Use a clean container to store drinking water
- 5. Always cover water completely
- 6. Use safe (uncontaminated) containers
- 7. Take without touching water
- 8. Individual cups/container
