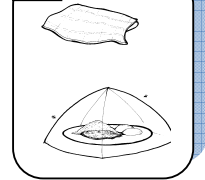

ACTIVITY: 13. Blocking the Route **TIME: 2 Hours**

1. Ask the group to think of all the ways that **FLIES** could enable the transmission of faeces to our mouths.
2. Hand out the Transmission pictures (left), and ask each person to come to the front and explain their card.
3. Now hand out the recommended practices (right), the cards that show ways to 'block the route' of the transmission of diarrhoea by **FLIES**.

TRANSMISSION PRACTISES

1. Leaving rotten food about.
2. Exposed garbage without bags.
3. Animals spreading garbage.
4. Eating fly-walked food from vendors.
5. Open defecation attracting flies.
6. Toilets smelling of urine / faeces.
7. Disposing of kimbies (disposable nappies) without safe plastic bag.

RECOMMENDED PRACTICES

1. Dispose of food scraps in a plastic bag in a sealed rubbish bin.
2. Dispose of garbage in black plastic bags in area secure from animals.
3. Cover left-over food with net or cloth.
4. When buying food from vendors take it hot and freshly cooked.
5. Keep area free from flies by burying all exposed faeces.
6. Leave the toilet clean after use.
7. Clean the toilet regularly.

HOMEWORK: Always dispose of your garbage safely
