

15. DIARRHOEA THROUGH FRUIT

- 2. Ask participants to arrange the cards to make a story. They need not use all the cards at once.
- 3. Now hand out the cards (right) that show ways to 'block the route' of the transmission of diarrhoea by buying FRUIT (or other raw food) from vendors.

RECOMMENDED













TRANSMISSION PRACTICES

- 1. Eating raw fruit without peeling
- 2. Buying fruit from vendors with poor hygiene.
- 3. Eating uncooked fruit or salads.
- 4. Defecating under fruit trees.
- 5. Collecting fruit off the ground.
- 6. Using animal or human manure on salad or fruit that grows on the ground.
- 7. Cutting up fruit/salad with dirty hands.
- 8. Storing unwashed fruit in lunch box.
- 9. Flies contamination of fruit.

RECOMMENDED PRACTICES



- 1. Peeling fruit before eating
- 2. Washing all unpeeled fruit before eating.
- 3. Cooking fruit before eating.
- 4. No open defecation.
- 5. Do not eat ripe fruit from the ground without washing.
- 6. Washing hands before eating.
- 7. Be careful to wrap sandwiches separate from fruit when storing together in a lunch box.
